General objectives of the course

By the end of the course the students are expected to:

- Understand the conceptual framework of place and displacement, highlighting the existence of different types of displacement in dialogue with education
- Engage the students into the discursive constructions of displacement in terms of causes and consequences
- Reveal different ways of resisting displacement in education and to explore transformative ways for raising awareness and advocacy

The course includes experiential & reflective activities

Assessment: Students' assessment tasks will include a) Their participation in the seminars with projects (30%); one written essay of 2500 words (60%); the presentation of the essay (10%).

Essay topics and directions will be provided by the lecturers.

Submission deadline: The essay should be submitted online in the course Moodle platform by May 25. The presentations will be held the last week or 2 weeks depending on the number of students.
